

## **2 TIMOTHY 3:1-9**

<sup>3</sup><sup>1</sup>But understand this,  
that in the last days  
there will come times of difficulty.

<sup>2</sup>For people will be  
lovers of self,  
lovers of money,  
proud,  
arrogant,  
abusive,  
disobedient to their parents,  
ungrateful,  
unholy,  
<sup>3</sup>heartless,  
unappeasable,  
slanderous,  
without self-control,  
brutal,  
not loving good,  
<sup>4</sup>treacherous,  
reckless,  
swollen with conceit,  
lovers of pleasure  
rather than lovers of God,  
<sup>5</sup>having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power.

Avoid such people.

<sup>6</sup>For among them are those who creep into households  
and capture weak women,  
burdened with sins  
and led astray by various passions,  
<sup>7</sup>always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth.

<sup>8</sup>Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses,  
so these men also oppose the truth,  
men corrupted in mind  
and disqualified regarding the faith.

<sup>9</sup>But they will not get very far,  
for their folly will be plain to all,  
as was that of those two men.
