2. <u>Read 2 Corinthians 8:16-24 (page 1165)</u> . What's this passage addressing, according to verse 20? And what's Paul's concern, according to verse 21?
3. In what ways are the collection arrangements described in this passage honourable is God's sight?
4. How many people make up the delegation appointed to collect the Corinthians' money What characterizes the members of that delegation? How does the nature of that delegation make the collection arrangements honourable in the sight of man?
5. In what other ways are the collection arrangements described in this passag honourable in the sight of man?
6. Why has Paul explained all this to the Corinthians, according to verse 24? And wh does he use the phrase "for your benefit" in verse 23?

7. How might the teaching of this passage be applied to evangelical churches today? And

how should it be applied to the members of such churches?
